Dear Friends of the Whiteside Theatre:

It's been a busy Spring for the Whiteside Theatre! First and foremost, The Whiteside Theatre Foundation is very proud to announce that the Whiteside Theatre is now listed on the National Register of Historic Places! The National Park Service (which administers the list and evaluated our application to it) released the official announcement on March 6th, 2009. The placement of the theatre on the National Register of Historic Places is the culmination of over a year's hard work by many local dedicated theatre volunteers, with much-appreciated expert assistance from the State of Oregon's Advisory Committee on Historic Preservation. Placement of the ornate Whiteside Theatre on the National Register came 20 years after the Italian Renaissance building was officially designated as a downtown historic resource by the City of Corvallis. tion for the 1922 building, the listing on the National Register can provide federal tax credits, and may help secure needed grant money. Look soon for the official bronze plaque celebrating Corvallis' newest addition to the National Register of Historic Places!!


