### GHOST S OF THE WHITESIDE TOURS ON OCT 28TH

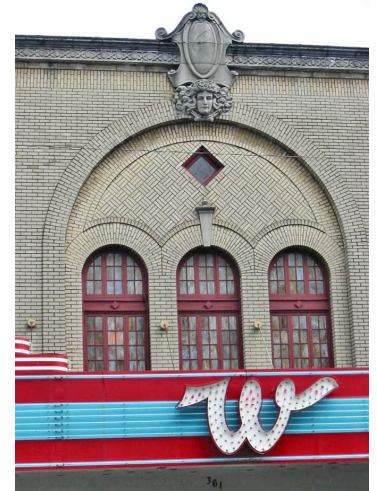
